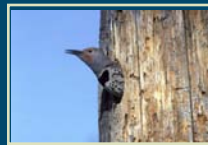
Eight Required Elements

2. **Habitat** extent and condition
3. **Problems** and research needs
4. **Conservation Actions** and priorities

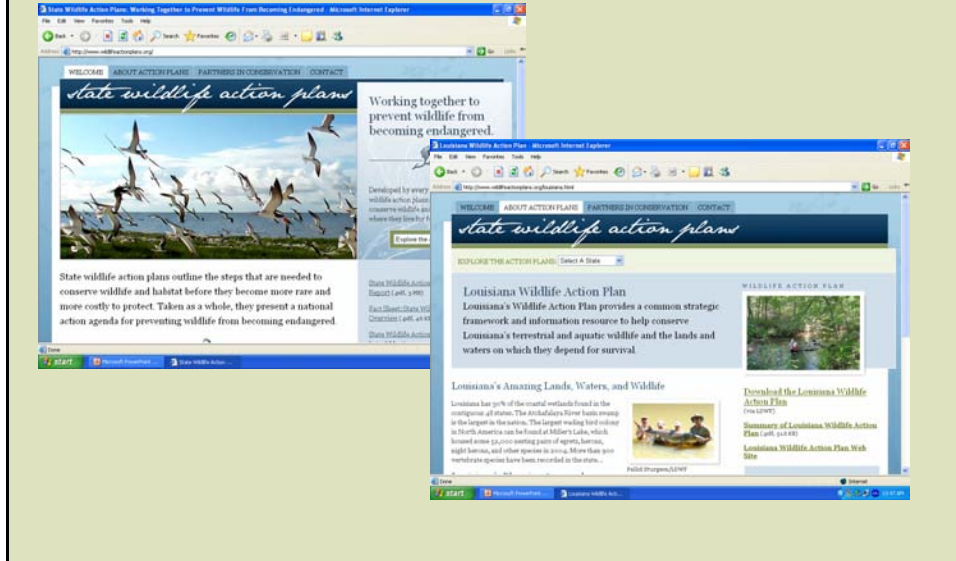


Eight Required Elements

6. Plans to **Review and Revise**
7. **Coordination** with other agencies, planning efforts
8. Broad **public participation**
