Ms. Michal Pelzig is senior manager of Sustainability at Hess Corporation, where she is responsible for the company's public sustainability reporting, investor environmental, social and governance (ESG) surveys and development of environment, health, safety and social responsibility strategy. She has been the principal architect of Hess' sustainability reporting strategy, including the Global Reporting Initiative and CDP, and has helped Hess attain recognition as the most sustainable energy-producing company in the United States based on third-party rankings.

Michal has also been extensively involved in the implementation of Hess' climate change strategy, most notably in the area of carbon markets, carbon offsets and renewable energy certificates. Additionally, she developed Hess' Scope 3 greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) reporting and initiated the company's annual third-party GHG emissions assurance process. Michal also chairs the Climate Reporting Task Force of IPIECA, the global oil and gas industry association for environmental and social issues, leading the development of a common understanding and framework for members to publicly report on their companies' management of relevant, high priority climate change issues.

Ms. Pelzig holds undergraduate degrees in marine biology/biochemistry from Southampton College, a bachelor's degree in geology from Texas A&M University (Corpus Christi) and a master's degree in biochemical sciences from Princeton University.
