You can apply to join the 2024 Global Network Forum if you are:

- an active member of Women in Water Diplomacy Network in the Nile, Central Asia & Afghanistan, Southern Africa, North America or other basin communities
- a water diplomat or water expert committed to advancing gender equality (male champions included)
- a young water diplomat (35 years old and younger)
- a development or implementation **partner** representative
- Engaged in a women's mediation network such as the Finnish women's mediation network.

#### How will participants be selected/ sponsored?

- We have limited resources, time, and space.
- We expect an estimated 60-80 participants.
- Sponsorship determined by engagement rate; and overall group composition goals for the 2024 Global Network Forum.
- We aim to provide sponsored participation packages to a diverse range of Network members across a variety of regions and areas of expertise.
- Network members under the age of 35 are strongly encouraged to apply.
- We invite partners that can sponsor their own costs to consider joining (or sponsoring a young professional).
- Applications will be assessed and approved on a rolling basis so apply early! March 2024 is right around the corner.
- Final deadline is January 5, 2024.
