Area of heightened concern. If within a restoration plan boundary, be sure to check that document for any additional permit limits, terms, or conditions that need to apply. Consider requiring additional monitoring, especially if there is limited monitoring data in the area. Check for inclusion of topographic maps or geologic structure maps in the permit application to identify sinkholes, subsurface fractures, special site conditions, or karst features. If there are no such maps, consider asking for some through the Request for Additional Information process.	30 to < 50 points
