Mr. Lung is a visiting fellow at the American Council for an Energy Efficient Economy and a consultant on energy management, technology delivery and energy efficiency policy. He previously served as Director of the Alliance to Save Energy's Industrial Program where he supported the development of industrial energy efficiency programs and standards including ISO 50001 and Superior Energy Performance.

Previously, as a Senior Associate at Resource Dynamics Corporation, Mr. Lung performed research and analysis on industrial energy efficiency and distributed generation technologies.
