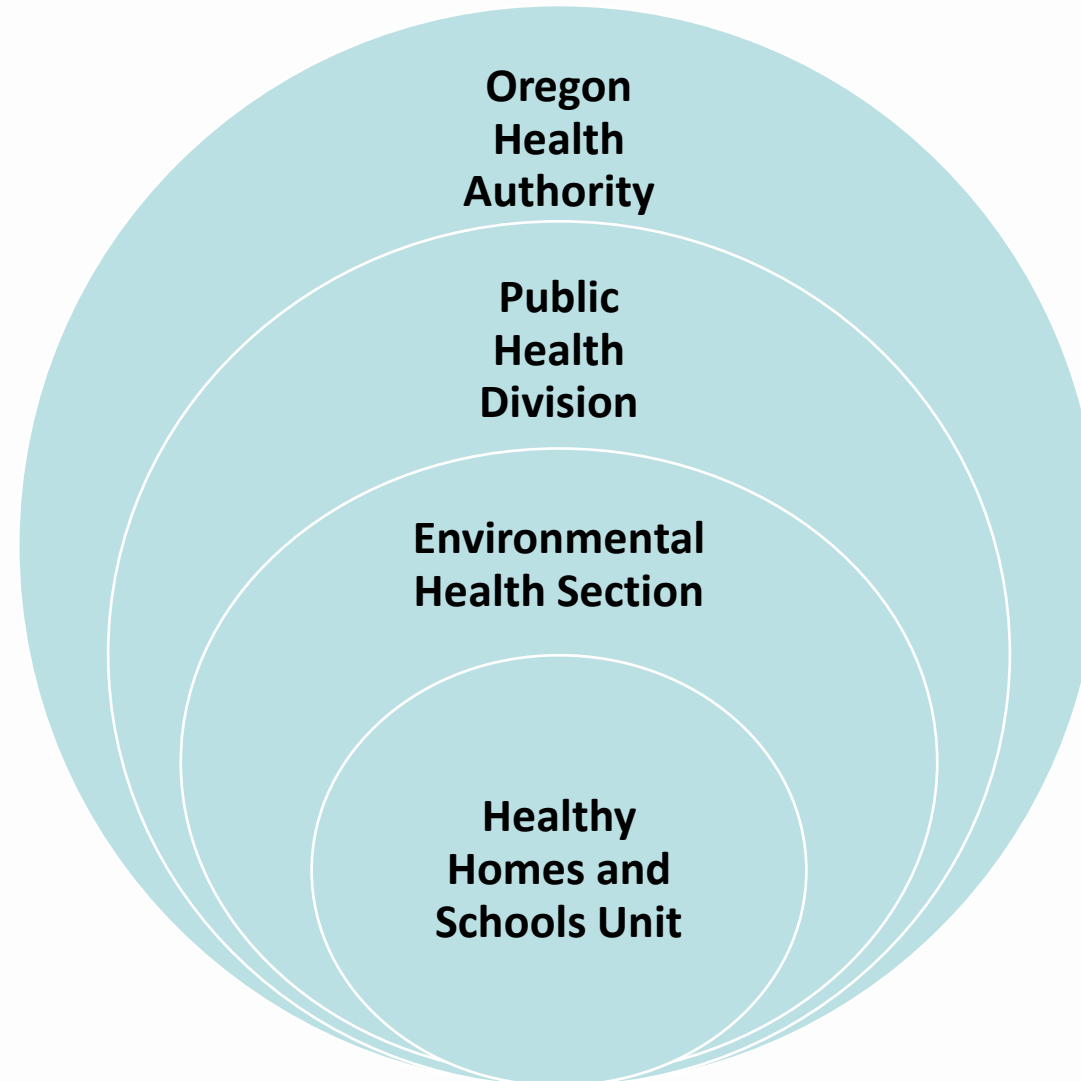

# Healthy Homes Grant Program

HHGP provides “grants to **eligible entities** that provide financial assistance to persons in **low-income households** to **repair and rehabilitate** their residences and to landlords to repair and rehabilitate dwelling units inhabited by low-income households.”

- (Oregon [HB 2842](#), 2021; additions made with [SB 1536](#), 2022)

# HHGP Mission

“...to **improve housing conditions** and **health outcomes** for **low-income Oregonians**, including:

- Communities of color;
- Immigrant and refugee communities;
- LGBTQ community;
- Communities experiencing health inequities;
- Tribal communities;
- Rural communities;
- Remote communities;
- Coastal communities;
- Communities with limited infrastructure; and
- Other communities traditionally underrepresented in public processes and adversely harmed by environmental and health hazards, including seniors, youth, and persons with disabilities.”
